AMENDED TRUST DEED
(Amended w.e.f 15-03-2023)

This amended Deed of Trust executed on this 15th of March 2023 by the Trustees of M.R. EDUCATIONAL TRUST Jagadhri Road, Bilaspur, Distt Yamuna Nagar, Haryana.

Whereas Sh. Ajmer Singh S/o Mukh Ram, aged about 75 years, resident of Vill. Chanda Kheri, P.O. Bilaspur, Tehsil Bilaspur, Distt. Yamuna Nagar, had settled a Trust called as "M.R. Educational Trust" on 12th day of June 2008 under the Indian Trust Act. 1882 and had got the same registered with the Sub Registrar Bilaspur vide Registration No. 586 dated 24-06-2008 and appointed a Board of Trustee to run the affairs of the Trust.

This Trust Deed amended on 09-06-2011 and registered vide Registration No. 912 on dated 14-06-2011 in Book No. 1 on Pages No. 69 to 89. And its additional copy was pasted in Book No. 1, File No. 1180 on pages 91 to 92.

This Trust Deed was also amended on 06-10-2014 and registered vide Registration No. 2,356 on dated 21-11-2014 in Book No. 1 on Pages No. 90 to 100. And its additional copy was pasted on Book No. 1, File No. 1,567 on pages 100 to 102.

And whereas now a new board has taken over and in order to run the Trust in democratic manner and also to ensure just and equitable participation of all Trustees in the working of the Trust and also to ensure that the very spirit under which the Trust was established is secured; the Board has unanimously decided to amend the trust deed in the manner appearing herein after:





MUKH RAM hereinafter referred to as "the said Trust" for carrying out the educational and charitable objects & purposes wide enough for the extension of the benefit thereof to all, irrespective of class, community, creed and relief of poor, education (any level), medical relief and advancement of any object of general and/or public utility with special emphasis on women empowerment & rural development, so that such benefit may be given/provided directly by said trust.

The Settler being inter alia, absolutely seized and possessed of the sum of Rs. 11000/- (Eleven thousand only) upon trust as nucleus of a starting funds for the said Trust for its objects and purpose and with and subject to the powers and provisions hereinafter declared and contained of and concerning the same in the manner here in after appearing. However, all the trustees for achieving the objects of the trust will invest the money in shape of contribution/donation. Required funds will also be collected from friends, relatives & society for Corpus/Trust Fund.

AND WHEREAS prior to the execution of these presents, the Settler having contributed the said sum of Rs. 11000 (Rupees Eleven thousand only) in cash to the Trustees.

The Trustees shall stand possessed of the said sum of Rs.11,000 (Rupees Eleven thousand only) and the profits and income thereof and the stock, fund, securities, donations, contributions, subscriptions and amalgamations that may hereafter be collected by the Trustees under these presents and the properties movable and immovable for the time being representing the same respectively (hereinafter called as "the Trust Funds") upon the Trust and with and subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter declared and contained of and concerning the same, that is to say.

- a) Upon Trust in the first instance to collect the dividends, interests, rents, profits and other income of the Trust Funds (hereinafter for brevity's sake called 'the income of the Trust Funds') and from & out of the same in the first place pay all the proper costs, charges and expenses of the Trust Funds and incidental to the collection thereof & all outgoings payable in respect of the Trust Funds and any immovable property of properties for the time being subject to the trusts hereof as also the costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the execution, management and administration of the trusts and powers herein contained.
- b) Subject to the provision of sub-clause (a) of this clause, the Trustees shall hold the trust Funds upon trust (so that as far as practicable that corpus shall always remain intact and only the income thereof shall be used, but with liberty to the Trustees at their discretion to use the corpus from time to time either wholly or in part or parts) for the public charitable purpose including:
 - c) Relief to the poor/deserving persons;
 - i. Advancement of education (any level);
 - ii. Medical relief,
 - iii. Advancement of any other object of general public utility not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit as the law may regard as Charitable purpose as the Trustees may think fit and for one or more of such charitable purposes to the exclusion of other or others as the Trustees may think fit provided that the income as well as the capital as well as the corpus shall be applied only towards the charitable purposes as aforesaid and any accumulation of income shall also be made and deemed to be made for application to such charitable purposes as aforesaid PROVIDED FURTHER:

a) That notwithstanding anything hereinbefore or hereinafter contained, the income as also the corpus of the Trust Funds shall be applied and

be applicable only, to or for such charitable purposes and objects and subject to such conditions or limitations if any as may from time to time be laid down in the Income Tax Act 1961, or any other Act governing the taxation of income as will ensure or make the Trust hereby established and its income as eligible for exemption from taxation under the Income Tax Act 1961, or any replacement or re-enactment thereof or modification thereof or under any other Government taxation for the time being in force in India.

- b) And further so that the Trust hereby established shall be one to which the provisions of Section 80 G of the Income Tax Act, 1961, or any replacement, re-enactment or the modification thereof for the time being in force shall apply so that any donation thereto be recognized eligible for exemption or relief from tax in regard to the donor.
- c) Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing objects or purposes but subject as aforesaid IT IS DECLARED that the Trustees shall in each year apply the income of the Trust Funds and may at the discretion at any time and from time to time apply also the Trust Funds or any part or parts of the Trust Funds in or towards anyone or more of the following objects or purposes (which according to the taxation laws be charitable objects or purposes) to the exclusion of the other or others of them in such proportion and manner in all respects without distinction or Irrespective of religion, caste or creed as the Trustees may in their absolute discretion think proper, that is to say:

Now therefore, this amended deed of trust witnesses as under:

1. NAME OF THE TRUST

The Trust shall be called "M.R. EDUCATIONAL TRUST", Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar (hereinafter referred to as the 'TRUST').



2. REGISTERED OFFICE

- a) The Head office of the Trust is at M.R. International School, Jagadhri Road, Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar. It may be shifted to any other place as decided by the Trustees from time to time.
- b) State level branch office(s) and sub-branch office(s) shall be opened to run and where within the Territory of Indian union.
- c) State level branch(s), Office(s) and District sub-office(s) shall function in accordance with the instructions issued from Head office from time to time.

3. AREA OF OPERATION

Whole of India, especially state of Haryana.

4. AIMS AND OBJECTS:

- a) To work for upliftment of Education of any level with special emphasis on women education/empowerment i.e. Professional & Technical Education, Higher Education & Medical/Health Education etc. and to promote & develop education, employment, science and technology and prosperity of humanity by way of establishment of different Educational, Research & Training Institutions. The institution(s) can be opened in any state under any name as per resolution passed by the founder Trustees.
- b) To help the poor/needy and intelligent students for their welfare and to spread education in the society at large. Special emphasis shall be done on welfare of SC/ST, Backward casts & Women especially economically backward persons etc.
- c) To establish school(s), college(s), Institution(s), University(s) Professional/Technical/Medical/Higher, Entrepreneurship/Scientific Development Organizations and opening Hospitals etc. for the welfare of the society. The same can be opened in any state or union territory. Also to develop Agriculture, Biotechnology & Industry related education and research work in any of the emerging areas including opening of Hotel/Motel/Resorts.
- d) To collaborate and cooperate with other professional bodies, trusts/societies and with educational and research institutions having similar objects in India and abroad.

- e) To open Charitable hospital to uplift the poor section of the society, to give scholarships to the needy, to arrange marriages of poor girls, to open old age homes and to maintain facilities for destitute, deaf and dumb and to uplift the poor section of the society through lectures & demonstrations and advertisements etc.
- f) To establish Entrepreneurship Development Centre(s) and/or STEP and/or TBI etc. and to conduct EACs/EDPs/MDPs/TEDPs/SDPs etc for the promotion of business and entrepreneurship in the country.
- g) To give donations/scholarships to authorized/recognized bodies for welfare of needy persons or to mitigate their hardships.
- h) To possess properties and funds, to receive donations & to administer and deal with them.
- i) To apply to the Central Government or State Government or other Institutions for allotment of land and building for the formation of educational institutions such as School, Public School, College, Charitable Hospital etc & for receiving grant(s) to fulfill the objectives of the Trust and to arrange donations for running the same.
- j) To adopt any running educational institution(s), hospital or any other organization(s) already working and rendering/giving education to the society as a large for uplift the standard and to help the management financially as well as educationally.
- k) To accept, purchase, receive, take on lease or hire or otherwise acquire any movable or immovable property, rights or privileges in the name of the trust.
- l) To establish, erect, equip and maintain or contribute towards establishments, erection, equipment and maintenance of colleges, schools, higher learning institutions, universities, bal-mandirs, libraries, Chowks/Crossing centers/places, free reading rooms, gymnasiums, swimming pools, hospitals, dispensaries, medical clinics - including clinics for tuberculosis patients, nursing homes, maternity homes, orphanages home for widows, destitute or other unattached woman, Vikas Grihas and charitable institutions for the relief of poor, education, medical relief and advancement of other objects of general public utility not involving the carrying on of any activity of profit.
- m) Endowments to different universities existing or which may hereafter come into existence for the purpose of encouraging education.

- n) Awarding scholarships and fellowships in cash or in such other form on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may think fit for the purpose of undertaking, prosecuting and encouraging studies PROVIDED THAT such scholarships and fellowships shall be awarded to such poor and/or deserving students and scholars studying in schools, colleges, universities and other educational institutions in India or abroad and who cannot afford and also of institution run by the Trust and have no means to prosecute the same.
- o) To make monthly or other periodical or lump-sum grants and contributions for the advancement of education of educational/research institutions.
- p) To render financial help to needy and deserving persons to enable them to obtain medical treatment either in India or abroad in cash or in such other forms and on such terms and conditions as Trustees shall deem fit PROVIDED HOWEVER that in case of medical treatment to be abroad, financial help should be rendered in India.
- q) To give financial help to needy widows and orphans for the purpose of their maintenance, medical treatment and education specially in arts and crafts, technical & professional studies so as to enable them to earn their livelihood.
- r) To distribute blankets, rage, woolen clothing, clothes or cotton, woolen, silken and other varieties of cloths etc to the needy.
- s) To start, maintain and assist any relief measures in those parts which are subject to nature calamities, like famine, fire, flood, dearth of water, earthquake, but of the revenue/profits of the Trust etc.
- t) To undertake any Program for rural development & women advancement/empowerment including any program for promoting the social and economic welfare of, or the uplift of the public in rural area, and the funds of the association/institution raised for this purpose would be utilized for the above object. PROVIDED FURTHER THAT, every contribution by trustees to any other trust, society or institution fund scheme or object having as its sole object all or any of the aforesaid charitable trusts and objects shall be treated and deemed to be a furtherance and achievement of the object for this Trust. PROVIDED FURTHER THAT notwithstanding anything contained hereinabove the Trustees shall have and absolute power by deed inter vivos or such other documents as may be necessary to delete any of the objects or provisions or any part of the aforesaid Trust which are found contrary to the concepts of public

charitable purposes or objects or outside of the Indian income Tax Act. 1961, or any re-enactment, replacement or modification thereof and other taxation law as may be applicable from time to time and enforced in India or the provisions of any other law relating to the public charities in India.

u) To do all other such acts and things as may be necessary to the attainment of the aforesaid objects as may fall within the purview of the trust act and keeping in conformity with the law of land.

5. The Trust shall have a succession but shall have a common seal and shall sue & be sued by the said name.

6. All the income of the Trust shall be utilized only for the betterment of the trust and its aims and objectives.

7. DEFINITIONS:

In this deed unless the context otherwise requires.

- i. Managing Committee shall mean the managing committee constituted/amended under Rules & Regulations of the trust.
- ii. President/Chairman/Settler/Chief Executive Officer shall mean the first trustee and Head of the Managing Committee of the Trust and all its institutions.
- iii. Vice President shall mean the first trustees of the Managing Committee of the Trust and all its institutions and will work in the absence of the President.
- iv. General Secretary/Cashier shall mean the first trustee of the Managing Committee of the Trust and all its institutions.
- v. Joint Secretary/Joint Cashier shall mean the first trustee of Managing Committee of the Trust and all its institutions.
- vi. Committee or sub-committee (Governing Council/Advisory body etc.) shall mean any committee set up by any two trustees to assist in the furtherance of its objects.
- vii. Officers and Staff shall mean every officer and staff member appointed by the Trustees/Managing Committee/Governing body etc to any office in the trust and institutions.

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8. MEMBERSHIP:

I. Trustees

FIRST TRUSTEES: - The first Trustees are 7 (seven) and the same can increase/alter as per the sole decision of the trustees in future. The Names and addresses of all the first trustees have been mentioned in this trust deed. New trustee in this category will be accepted only by decision of 2/3 majority of trustees.

In case of any vacancy due to death, voluntarily retirement etc. of any trustee, the vacancy will be filled from his/her legal heirs or by his/her will but if there is no legal heir or the legal heir is unfit to become Trustee of the Trust, then the rule of law will apply & Managing Committee is at liberty to co-opt/suggest the name(s) any person from the families of the founder trustees as Trustee in his or her place or any other person from the managing committee, as per trust act.

But in case of dispute among legal heirs then the living trustee can make any legal heir/other person as trustee against the vacancy and no legal action can lay against his/her this decision.

The Managing committee shall also be empowered to remove any member/Trustee from the committee in exceptional circumstances if the conduct of such member is not conducive to the trust norms and is creating hindrance in the smooth functioning of Trust activities by unanimous approval of rest of the members of Managing Committee.

II. Nominated Honorary Members to Managing Committee:

People who are considered beneficial to the Trust may be co-opted as honorary member by the trustees without the power to vote. They may be assigned any work to be done by the trustees. They will not enjoy any financial and administrative power what so ever. They may be paid honorarium for the work done for the trust/institutions. Initially two persons will be nominated members to managing committee. They will be having a usual time span of three years, if nominated to Governing body of institution(s), but their nomination can be canceled any time by the trustees and it is not compulsory to nominate any other person.

- VI. Honorary Members: The remaining nominated members will be honorary members

The present office bearers and members of the Managing Committee shall work for two years. Thereafter the members of the Managing committee shall be elected after every two years or at such interval which may be decided by the Managing Committee from time to time at the General body Meeting. The present office bearers at the time of amendment of this Trust deed are as follows and they shall work in accordance with the conditions mentioned herein above:

They shall be entitled to enjoy such privileges as honorarium as the Trustees/Managing committee may decide/suggest from time to time. For professional work trustees are allowed to take salary/honorarium as per the competency.

The meetings of the Trust will be called by the General Secretary/Cashier with prior approval of President. The notice of the general normal meeting will be

served on the trustees with at least seven days time. However, emergency meeting can be called any time.

The managing committee shall meet generally once in every 3 calendar month.

Four trustees will form the quorum. If any meeting is conducted without the presence of even three trustees, it would be treated as void/illegal.

10. PRESIDENT/CHAIRMAN/CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, VICE PRESIDENT/ VICE CHAIRMAN, GENERAL SECRETARY/ CASHIER AND JOINT SECRETARY/ JOINT CASHIER

The President, Vice President, General Secretary, Joint Secretary shall be elected for 2 (two) year term and shall be eligible for re-election as per unanimous decision of the Trustees.

10 A. The powers and duties of the President/Chairman/Chief Executive Officer, Vice Chairman shall be as under:

- i. To preside over and conduct the meetings of the Trust. The President/CEO shall be Chief Executive of the trust and shall be responsible for general administration of trust and its institutions.
- ii. To see that this constitution, Rules and Regulations are faithfully observed.
- iii. To be responsible for the better financial management, progress of the Trust and the Institutions of the trust.
- iv. President shall be fully competent to constitute and dissolve any committee, what so-ever within the constitution.
- v. President shall be empowered to sanction the bills and order for procurement of items required for trust and its institutions.
- vi. President are fully competent to borrow money un such security as shall be specified in the resolution of the trustees/Managing Committee and for that purpose sign, seal, deliver, and execute such deeds, documents and writings and do such acts, deeds, matters and things, as may be deemed necessary.
- vii. President are fully competent to apply for establishing new Colleges or for applying for new courses in its existing Colleges or for establishment of a University / Universities and to earmark Trust's land/building and funds, required for the same. Any other decision required for the fulfillment of trust's objectives can be taken by them.
- viii. To appoint, dismiss, transfer, promote employee(s) or otherwise punish the employee(s) of the Trust and of all the branches and institutions.
- ix. The President shall also operate upon the trust bank accounts jointly with Signatures of any one from General Secretary/Cashier or Joint Secretary/ Joint Cashier.

Tehsil Bilaspur (Yamuna Nagar)

- x. To arrange funds, appoint the necessary staff, create Infrastructure and it will also monitor the implementation of the projects run by the Trust.
- xi. To use such other power and to perform any other functions as may be necessary for the discharge of their duties of the Trust/institutions and for achieving the objectives of Trust.
- xii. Vice President/Vice Chairman will work in the absence of President/Chairman/C.E.O. Whatever may be the powers given in para-10 A.

10 B. The power & duties of the General Secretary/Cashier & Joint Secretary/ Joint Cashier.

- i. To execute the work of Trust.
- ii. To call meetings of the trust with Prior approval of the President & keep the record of the proceeding of the meetings.
- iii. To realize subscription, donation, contributions, loan, fees etc and issue of official receipts with counter signature of the President and the same will be deposited by him/her in the bank account of the trust in a day or two.
- iv. To carry out all the official correspondence on behalf of the trust.
- v. She/he shall be responsible for regular & proper maintenance of the accounts of the trust and all its branches & institutions.
- vi. To keep & imprest money or balance up to rupees 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand Rupees Only) to be fully empowered to sanction bills cash memos up to rupees 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand Rupees Only) against the budgetary provision but such total amount will not exceed rupees 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand Rupees Only) in a month.
- vii. To manage, supervise & control all the departments, institutions & activities of the trust under the guidance & approval of the President.
- viii. She/he is fully empowered to enter into any contract agreement for furtherance of large interest & welfare of the trust with the prior written approval of the President only.
- ix. Joint Sectary/Joint Cashier will work in the absence of General Secretary/ Cashier whatever may be the powers given in para 10 B.

11. REMOVAL FROM MEMBERSHIP:

Trustees are fully empowered to remove any honorary member of the Trust (with or without giving any notice/reason) on any of the following grounds:

- i. For acting in any way prejudicial to the interest of the Trust.
- ii. Having failed to perform the duties entrusted to him/her.
- iii. Leakage of any confidential matter etc.

12. FORMATION OF MANAGING COMMITTEE

The Managing Committee has already been given in (para 9) of this trust deed. However, Governing body with the consent of trustees will formulate and Implement programs for the promotion of the aims-and objectives of the Trust.

13. PROCEEDINGS OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE / TUSTEES EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING(S)

The General Secretary/Cashier or Joint Secretary/ Joint Cashier shall record within thirty days minutes of proceedings of the Committee Meetings in the Minutes Book kept for the purpose after getting the same approved by the President of the said meeting

14. WINDING UP OR DISSOLUTION OF THE TRUST:

Assets and liabilities accrued by trust, all its branches and institutions will be property of the Trust. If the Trust fails due to some or other grounds, it shall be merged with some other Trust/society with similar objects and if purpose of the Trust is changed, the same will also be charitable /social in nature with the resolution of the Trustees by consensus.

The duties of all the officers and members shall be to work for the betterment and progress of the Trust, as per the decision of the Trustees.

15. AND whereas to give more clarity to Dissolution clause, the old clause No. 14 is to be substituted now with clear heading and language. In case the trustees unanimously decide to dissolve the trust, the trust funds/ assets shall be donated to

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some other trust / society having objects similar to those of this trust. Under no circumstances the assets of the trust shall be transferred to any particular member or office bearers of the Trust.

16. AUDITING OF ACCOUNTS

The accounts of the Trust of all its branches and of all its institutions shall be kept separately and shall annually be audited by independent chartered accountant/auditor(s) appointed by the Trustees. Such audited accounts shall be placed at the annual meeting of the Trustees.

17. INVESTMENT OF FUNDS

BANK ACCOUNT

The trust may open one or more Bank Account(s) in any bank in India or abroad. President/CEO, Vice President/Vice Chairman and any one among General Secretary/Cashier or Joint Secretary/Joint Cashier jointly to operate the same. All subscriptions, donations, grants, contribution and other monies of the trust shall be deposited in the Bank Account(s) of the trust.

18. The Trustees shall have power in their discretion to accept upon such, terms as they may think fit any donations or contributions which any person may be desirous of making to the Trust Funds (whether such donations, contributions be of money shares and securities, debentures, bonds, stocks, and/or other property, movable and/or immovable). PROVIDED ALWAYS THAT the terms upon which such donations or contributions shall be accepted shall not, in any way, be inconsistent with or repugnant to the objects of these presents and shall only be for the purpose of the Trusts created under these presents to be utilized only in furtherance of its objects. PROVIDED ALWAYS AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED AND DECLARED that save as otherwise expressly provided by the terms of the donations, or contribution aforesaid the Trustees shall, in their absolute discretion, be entitled to treat such donations or contributions or and part thereof as part of the corpus of the Trust Funds or to utilize such donations or contributions or any part thereof for the furtherance and fulfillment of the objects of the Trust.

19. The Trustees shall have the power to let, sublet or given on lease & license basis or otherwise the immovable properties belonging to the Trust from month to month and from year to year or for any term of years or in perpetuity and to sell, exchange and purchase immovable properties upon such terms and conditions as they may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.
20. The Trustees shall have the power in their discretion to make any additions, alterations and improvements to the immovable property or properties or the Trust Funds and to develop the same from time to time in such manner as they, in their discretion deem fit and proper from time to time.
21. The Trustees shall if the situation so required be entitled in their discretion to borrow money from industries, banks & financial institutions upon such terms, conditions and securities as the Trustees in their discretion deem fit and proper from time to time and to manage the Trust property comprised in- these presents as security for repayment of the loans borrowed for the purpose of the Trust.
22. The Trustees shall be empowered to carry on any trade, service, industry or exhibition which in the opinion of the Trustees and subject to the provisions of Indian Income Tax Act, 1961, Indian Trust Act, 1882 for the time being in force are permissible and are essential, incidental or conducive to the attainment or for the fulfillment of all or any or the objects of the Trusts.
23. The number of Trustees or these presents shall not be less than two at point of time and the Trustees shall be entitled to appoint additional Trustee or Trustees as and when the Trustees deem fit. The said Trustees of these presents shall act as Trustees for life or until anyone resign or otherwise vacate their office. However, any or the said trustees may at any time resign his office or the Trustee by giving three months notice to his co-trustee and upon the expiry of such period, such trustee shall be deemed to have vacated his office (in this case, legal heirs).
24. In case and so often as the Trustees hereby constituted or any of them shall die or desire to retire or refuse or become incapable to act in the Trust hereof or take the benefit of the insolvency Law for the time being in force then and in every such case it shall be lawful for the surviving or continuing Trustees for the time being or these presents (and for this purpose the retiring or refusing Trustees shall if willing to act in the exercise of this power be considered a Continuing Trustee) to

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appoint a new Trustee and more number of their family In this case, legal heirs of trustees with automatically become trustees after attaining the age of majority as per contract act 1872.

25. All records, minutes books, title deeds, securities, account books, vouchers, papers and documents relating to the Trust shall remain in the custody of such person or persons and at such places as the Trustees may from time to time determine.

26. The Trustees shall be entitled to make rules and regulations for the management of the Trust and all matters relating to the Trust and Trust Funds and their management including the conduct of the meetings of the Trustees provided such rules and regulations shall not be repugnant to the provisions hereof or offend against the purpose of the Trust or be inconsistent herewith.

27. The Trustees shall be entitled at their discretion to employ Solicitors, Attorneys and legal advisors and advisory Council and to appoint any committees at any place or places as they may think necessary for working of the Trust.

28. The Trustees for the time being for these presents are entitled to reimburse themselves or pay and discharge out of the Trust Funds all expenses incurred in or about the execution of the Trusts and powers of these presents. Salary for their professional work is also admissible of Trust funds. She/he/They may be Director/CEO of any organization run by Trust and/or run by any other trusts/organization.

29. IT IS HEREBY EXPRESSLY AGREED AND DECLARED THAT the Trustees shall have the power by an unanimous resolution in that behalf to modify, enlarge or terminate any of the objects and purposes of these presents or any other power or provisions of these presents without however affecting in any way the general object and purpose of the Trust for utilizing the Trust Funds and the income of the Trust Funds for the charitable purpose only for the benefit of all without distinction of the caste, creed and religion and to the intent that the Trust Fund and the Income thereof shall at all times hereafter be utilized for such charitable purposes only and not otherwise and on the Trustees resolving to terminate any particular object or purpose of any particular power or provision as aforesaid the same shall thereafter cause to be applicable but without prejudice to the rights of the Trustees by similar unanimous resolution to restore any such modification

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thereto as the Trustees may consistently with the provision of this clause determine. PROVIDED ALWAYS that notwithstanding anything hereinbefore or hereinafter contained the income as also corpus of the Trust. Funds shall be applied and be applicable only to or for such charitable purpose and objects only and within such territories only and 15 subject to such condition or limitation if any as may from time to time be laid down in the Income tax Act, 1961 or any other Act governing the taxation of incomes as will ensure or make the Trust hereby established and its income as eligible for exemption from taxation under the Income - tax Act, 1961 or any replacement re-enactment or modification thereof or under any Act governing taxation for the time being in force in India and further so that the Trust hereby established shall be to which the provisions of Section 80G of the Income tax Act, 1961, or any replacement, reenactment or modification thereof for the time being in force shall apply so that any donation thereto be recognized. Eligible for exemption or release from tax in regard to the Donor.

30. ALTERATION IN RULES:

These rules and regulations may be amended and altered by the Trust but the new rules and regulations shall not be inconsistent with or contrary to the aims and objects of this constitution or the duties and powers reserved under the rules or authority of any office bearer the Trust.

If any question arises whether any person has been duly elected or appointed or is entitled to be member of any authorities or other body of the Trust, the matter shall be referred to the Trustees, whose decision there on shall be final.

All properties (moveable or immovable) by way of gift, endowment, purchase or otherwise shall be acquired in the name of the Trust or as resolved and all such properties when so acquired shall vest in the Trust.

All properties so acquired either for the head office or any branch office(s) shall be devoted to and for the purpose and in case of donation according to the intention of donors as the case may be.

The Trust reserves the right to purchase/sale land and/or acquires building for its benefit or in the larger interest of the Trust.

In case of any dispute with the Trust or concerning the functioning of the Trust for any kind of dispute, which pertains to the Trust would be referred to Trustees for final decision.



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All the Civil suits by or against the Trust or its offices or institutions shall be filled only in the Civil Courts at Bilaspur (Yamuna Nagar).

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that the Trust shall be and remain irrevocable for all times to come but in case the Trustees so decide unanimously, they may hand over the corpus of the Trust Fund to any other Trust or Institution or Society being a Society registered under the Societies Registration Act, having identical or similar object and purposes on such terms and conditions as the Trustees purpose that thereafter the Trust Fund shall be owned and managed by such Trust/Institution or Society for the purpose or their objects.




